

I believe that 40 years ago with the Charismatic Renewal, the Holy Spirit gave us the opportunity for a renewal of the faith and zeal in the Church. We experienced the power of the Spirit with the charisms we needed for our time for a new evangelization.

When we hear the word "evangelization" we think going out like the Apostles bringing the good news. It is important and still today.
