

# Reflection

June is the month of the Sacred Heart. This image of Jesus holding his heart is a human way for Him who is God to speak more powerfully about this love He manifested on the cross. He knew that we needed images, signs, and powerful statements that would stay with us, or among us, as a reminder at least for a while, that would captive our eyes and minds in order to stir up a little bit of... compassion and love.

In the first reading the prophet Zechariah is telling us that the Lord will pour out a spirit of compassion and supplication just by looking at the One whom they have pierced, namely Jesus.

Jesus is not a self-centered God like the Greek gods who could be very selfish. On the contrary, our God does not want us to pay back. It is impossible. What He wants us is to realize that He loves us, proved it and that we pay no attention for what he has done for us. We know Jesus, his name, his story but do we know his love for us?

God does not expect tears; He does not even expect feelings for him. He wants acceptance of his presence, of the revelation of his love for us to break the ice of our heart in order to be what we are supposed to be. The divine warming of our heart will take place when we will start to welcome more deeply in our lives the One who is still begging our attention in order to prevent us to fall back in an ice age that will take us away from Him.
