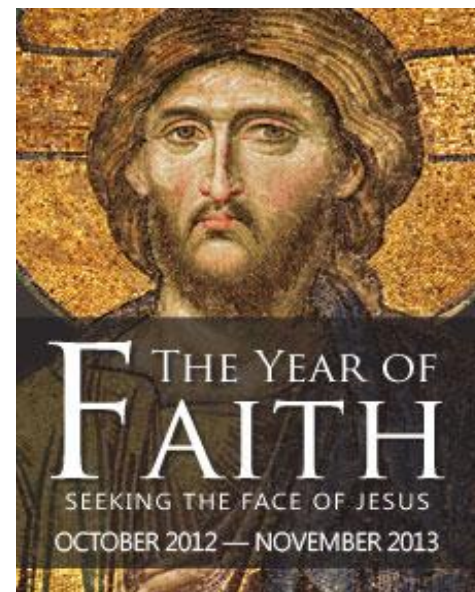

Corpus Christi Sunday was a wonderful day. It was the perfect day for that event; nice sun and temperature at the same time. The altars were tastefully decorated and much thought put into it.

One of the reasons I want to come back to this past event, is due to the contrast with what we do for God and what we do in our world for our gods we have, trying to find in them and through them reasons for joy and hope.

Monday, Neymar Júnior went to Barcelona. Neymar is a Brazilian soccer player, young and of course talented and already famous. He will join the well-known Braça soccer team next September (like the Senators for us!). On Monday, he went to Barcelona to be presented to the people. 50,000 thousand were gathered in the stadium to see him. Many of them standing far away and seeing just his back. They were there for just 20 minutes of show. There was probably nothing on TV in Spain that evening so people did not know what to do and took their cars, spending hours waiting for the special moment!
