God is judge but God also loves what is right. With God, if there is a condemnation, there is also a chance. God does not punish for the sake of punishment. God is looking for a movement of the heart. God wants reaction more than punishment; a relationship with him more than anything else. Saint Therese of Lisieux understood that because she based all her spirituality on one attitude: trust. This is the way to go to God even if we look at him as a judge. If we are confident in God's love and mercy, we should not be afraid to go to him. And we know as well that He will listen because even before we ask, God knows. The only thing we have to do is to trust.


