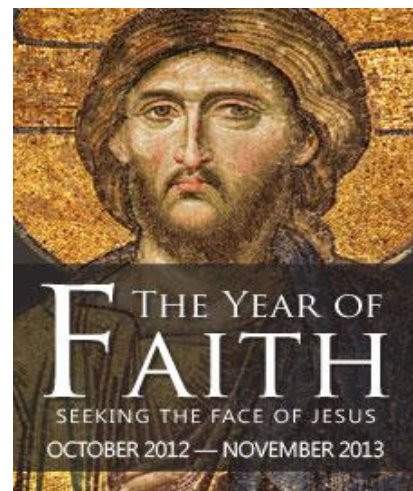

Reflection

A mother told me the story of her son who, when he was a year and an half, was playing outside by the pool. All of a sudden, looking up, he said out loud: "Look at the dove, it is a fire but it does not burn." Pretty Amazing. And as for the theology, it is pretty deep. Not really a surprise: Jesus told us that God reveals his secret to his little ones. Of course, we will tell me that the little boy could have heard the story of the dove at Jesus' baptism and made that story up: a little boy of 18 months of life? But what about the fire? I might be naïve, but I believe this story and in fact it gives me a great desire to be filled with this fire since it does not hurt....

The fire that does not hurt is like a water that does not get you wet... It is a special gift against human reason, to test our intelligence and to reveal something great. The story of the burning bush is similar. When the supernatural enters into the world, you do not have to come up with something rational. Otherwise you won't see the spiritual one. Either you are on your knees or you turn away if you think about it too much. A fire is usually something that destroys, but it is also something that transforms. Gold is purified in the fire to get its value. Without fire, it has no value. God is love, and since God is also seen as a fire, therefore, the fire that did not burn the bush and did not burn the little child, is only love. Love is a fire because this love transforms and purifies. Without this fire, we have no value. Let us then welcome this fire without fear.
