

<u>Reflection</u>

"I am the good shepherd." For a sheep, a shepherd of course is very important. A sheep needs to be led to find food, but also to have some for protection. A sheep is apparently not a very clever animal. However, I do not think that Jesus, by saying "my sheep hear my voice", He tried to tell us with "nice words and beautiful picture" that we are a little bit stupid. We are clever because we have God's capacity in us. However, sometime, when it is about to make good decisions, depending on our mood or our human inclination, we need someone to help us. It is not so much to have someone who will decide for us. It is more someone who knows what it is good. That 's why we need Jesus. We are sheep because we cannot find the way that will give us what we need. Left alone, the good food is not where we might think. In a time where we do not have a lot of example of good leadership, these words "I am the Good Shepherd" tells us that we can fully trust Him. He knows the best and only the best. And He has come to give us the best. The joy of God is to share what they have and to make us participant of their life. To hear these words " I am the Good Shepherd", we must also see Him with his cross which is his staff to lead us. His cross reminds Him his sacrifice for us so that we might share the best food. "on this mountain, the Lord of Hosts will make for all peoples a feast of rich food, a feast of well-aged wines" Isaiah 25:6.." He wants to take us there. And for us, his staff reminds us that He is "Good" because as St Paul would say, "thought we were sinners, he died for us." Rom 5:8. Now, what you have to do is simple: Follow Him. He knows where we can find what we need.
