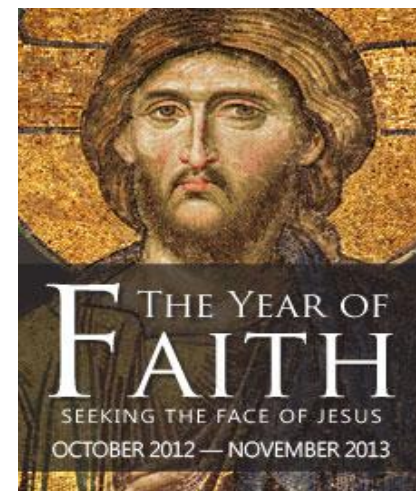

I Trust in You "My Heart is overwhelmed with great mercy for the souls and especially for the poor sinners. Oh, if they could only understand that I am for them the best Father, than for them from My Heart gushed forth Blood and Water like of an overflowing source of mercy; for them I live in the tabernacle; as King of Mercy desire to overwhelm the souls with graces, but they do not want to accept them. At least you come to Me as often as possible and take these graces that they do not want to accept and with this you will console My Heart. Oh, how much indifference from the souls for so many demonstrations of love. My Heart is only compensated with ingratitude, with forgetfulness on the part of the souls that live in the world. They have time for everything, but not to come to Me to take My graces".
