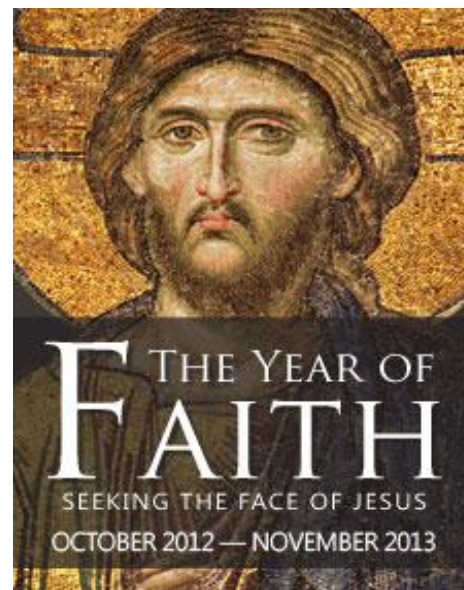

***Reflection***

The Gospel today is another challenging Gospel. Challenging is not always negative. When we think of challenge, we know it might be difficult but not feasible. Challenge with God has other aspects. One is that it is surprising ; something we never thought about because it is not the way our nature thinks, the way the world works. When God is challenging us, we should know that it is not impossible even if at first, we might see some difficulties.

We can ask ourselves. Why God is doing that? Because of the original sin, we are searching for what is the best for us. However, it does not mean that it will be the best for us. Very often it is not the best for God anyway. "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD in Isaiah. Another aspect is that the Lord is challenging us to see what is really in our heart. Are we going to listen to Him? This is maybe our first challenge...
