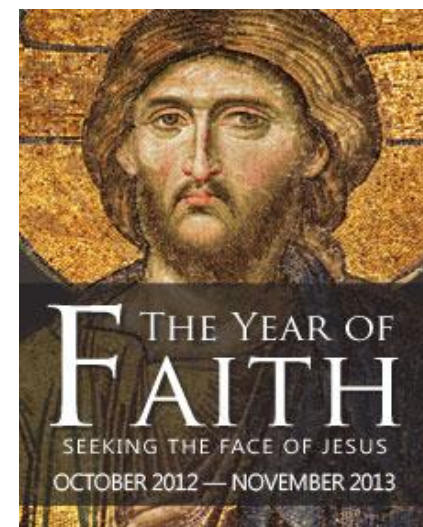
❖ George and Velda along with their family would like to thank their family and friend who come to extend their best wishes on their 50th anniversary of marriage.
