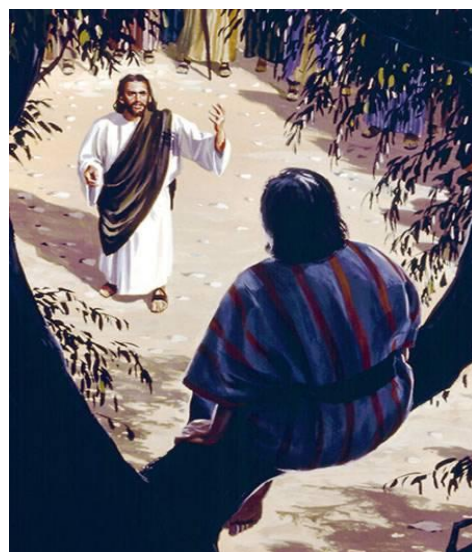

Reflection

What is the most important: All Saints or All Souls? In our tradition, November 01, after a night trying to digest the candies and chips from Halloween, we celebrate the Feast of All Saints. Usually, we skip this Solemnity of All Saints to put more emphasis on All Souls Day because it is dearer to us, a particular day of remembrance of our loved ones. However, as Christians, we should only see All Souls Day in the Solemnity of All Saints.

All Souls Day is a time of sadness for many people because someone is not with them anymore. Yes separation is always difficult. We should remember that in our faith, our separation due to death should only be experienced with God's promises. That is why we should celebrate All Saints as well because this is a celebration of fulfillment and the fulfillment of our loved ones. It is part of our belief, so we should look at this Solemnity as a celebration of hope because our folks are there with them. We can receive from this Solemnity the joy and hope that is sometimes missing in our lives because of the loss of someone. The Saints are telling us on this Solemnity that God's promises are true. There is a kingdom. There is something after death and our relatives are there celebrating God and waiting for us.

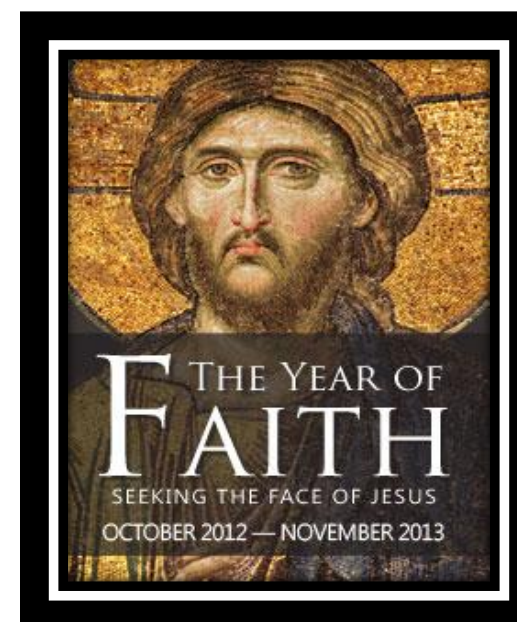
