Reflection

The word **Advent** means "coming" or "arrival." The focus of the entire season is the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ. Advent also symbolizes the spiritual journey of individuals and a congregation, as they affirm that Christ has come, that He is present in the world today, and that He will come again in power.

First Sunday of Advent: Jesus wants us to be ready, but leaves to us how we prepare ourselves for his Second coming.

Second Sunday of Advent: We need to live our baptismal faith and help to build a community of faith and trust in God.

Third Sunday of Advent: The coming of the Saviour will help us to understand what is in store for us.

Fourth Sunday of Advent: We need to open our eyes to recognize that the kingdom of God is near us and within us.
