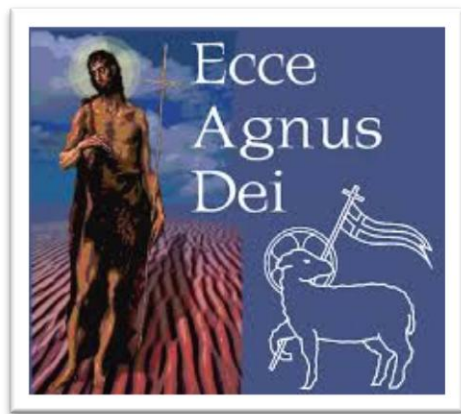

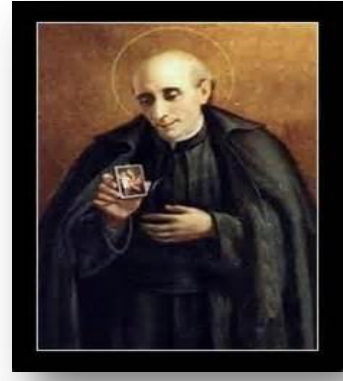

Second Sunday of Ordinary Time

John the Baptist saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.' I did not know him, but the reason why I came baptizing with water was that he might be made known to Israel." John 1, 29-34



St. Vincenzo Pallotti. 1795 – 1850
 St. Vincent Pallotti, was born in Rome April 21, 1795. Vincent as an ordained priest dedicated himself completely to God and care for souls. He dreamed of gaining for Christ all non-Catholics. He began a revival program which envisaged the collaboration of the laity with the clergy. He had an intense devotion to the mystery of the Most Blessed Trinity, and to the Virgin Mary. His contemporaries, including the pope, considered him a saint during his life. Vincent Pallotti worked selflessly looking after the poor in urban areas of Rome. He used donations he received for the poor and underprivileged. He founded guilds for workers, agricultural schools, loaning associations, orphanages and homes for girls. He was the pioneer and precursor of Catholic Action. Wishing to send missionaries to other parts of the world he founded the Union of Catholic Apostolate and "the Society of the Catholic Apostolate". Like St. Paul, Vincent strongly believed, that God wanted to save all people, so he started the Society of the Catholic Apostolate. His great legacy was the congregation he founded for urban mission work, known as the "Society for Catholic Action". This indefatigable laborer for Christ died January 22, 1850 from a severe cold which he most likely caught on a cold rainy night after giving his cloak to a beggar who had none. The following are mottos Pallotti used, "The love of Christ impels us" (Caritas Christi Urget Nos). "For the greater glory of God"; "For the destruction of Sin"; "For the Salvation of Souls"; The members of the Society of the Catholic Apostolate work as everyday missionaries to "renew faith and rekindle love."
 My Congregation is Called "The Society of the Catholic Apostolate". The group in India I belong to is "Khrist Jyothi" (Light of Christ) Province. The Feast day of our Patron and Founder, St. Vincent Pallotti is January 22.
