Reflection

Seventh Sunday of the Year: You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect!

In the Old Testament the word used for God is synonymous with 'Perfect' 'Blameless' and 'Holy'. "Be

Holy as I your God am Holy". God instructs Moses to tell the people to imitate the holiness of God and be kind and charitable in their lives because God does not want his people to exact vengeance or bear a grudge against one another. Holiness is not just extending our relationship with God but also with our brothers and sisters.

The Sermon on the Mount is both a challenge and a source of inspiration. What gives meaning to our response is the motivation which follows: love. Jesus challenges us to love our enemies and pray for those who mistreat us. Quite simply we are asked to be perfect and merciful like the Father.

Chesterton coined phrases that have a really deep meaning. The problem with Christianity is not that it has been tried and found wanting but that it has not been tried.

The words we pray every day in the Lord's Prayer: "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." When we say the Our Father we are saying that we will forgive those who cross the line of common decency so that we also might be forgiven for any ways that we have crossed the line.

If we refuse to forgive, we are refusing to accept the principles of Jesus Christ himself. Today Jesus places before us another guide-line. "Be perfect," he says, "just as your heavenly Father is perfect."

In his letter to the Corinthians Paul reminds us that we have received the Holy Spirit and if the Holy Spirit dwells in us, then we are his temples and God dwells within us. Paul says that worldly wisdom can destroy the Temple of the Lord so we need to live our lives dedicated to the Lord. Jesus chose the path of love and forgiveness even when he was wrongly judged, persecuted and killed. Forgiveness is a gift of God and those who ask him for this grace obtain it so freely because God is full of love and forgiveness.

Prayer: "Lord Jesus, your love brings freedom and pardon. Fill me with your Holy Spirit and set my heart ablaze with your love that nothing may make me lose my temper, ruffle my peace, take away my joy, or make me bitter towards others." Amen.
