In addition, all Catholics aged 14 and up must abstain from eating meat The **Obligation of Abstinence** (refraining from eating meat) begins at the age of 14. The law of fasting (limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals) obliges all between the ages of 14-59. No one should consider this obligation lightly.
