

<u>Reflection</u>

May Devotions to Mary: During the month of May, praying the Rosary is a traditional prayer in many a cultural setting. I remember having joined in many a devotion of the Rosary with singing hymns to Mary. This devotional practice in May ends with the litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary sung to the

accompaniment of the guitar or the violin. The devotions ended on May 31 with many hymns to Mary and this always ended with light refreshment, we children enjoyed the sweet delicacies. Praying the Rosary in the church began a while back but took momentum after the *Battle of Lepanto*. At dawn on October 7, 1571, Pope Pius V, accompanied by the faithful, prayed the Rosary in the **Basilica** of Santa Maria Maggiore. From dawn to dusk prayers continued in Rome as the Christians and the Muslims battled at Lepanto. When it was all over the Muslims had been defeated. Of some 270 Moslem ships, at least 200 were destroyed. The Turks lost 30,000 men while Christian casualties numbered between 4,000 and 5,000. Then on, the devotion to the Rosary increased. The Blessed Virgin Mary always gave this message. Pray the rosary for the conversion of sinners, and world peace. *Pope Francis* in his homily asked the people "Do you pray the Rosary every day? Well, prayer with Mary the Rosary, it sustains us in the battle against the evil one and his accomplices. In the Holy Mary we pray, "Holy Mary mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death". Saint Bernard declared, "The Mother of Christ and of the Church is always with us. Mary accompanies us, struggles with us, and sustains us in our fight against the forces of evil". Mary dwells in the joy and the glory of the Resurrection. The tears shed at the foot of the Cross have been transformed into a smile which nothing can wipe away, even as her maternal compassion towards us remains unchanged. "The Memorare", prayer expresses this sentiment very well. Mary loves each one of us. Pope Benedict XVI says, Mary's smile is a spring of living water. "He who believes in me", says Jesus, "out of his heart shall flow rivers of living water" (Jn. 7:38). **People take medication to sleep,** try this simple remedy and tell me if it works for you. Just before you go to bed or when in bed take the Rosary beads and pray a decade of the rosary, 1 Our Father and 10 Hail Mary's or if you can, recite the whole Rosary, the 5 decades, as sleepy as you are or even if you fall
