Fifth Sunday of Easter

Come to the Lord, a living stone, though rejected by human beings yet chosen and precious in God's sight. Like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house.

Peter 2, 4-9

<u>Reflection</u>

Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life! All of us have had the experience of being lost or losing our sense of direction some time or another in life.

Besides the experience of losing one's way, we are

sometimes at our wit's end when an unforeseen event, a tragedy or disaster hits us. We are sometimes forced to ask ourselves the question, "Where am I going?" How do we find our way back? Can our faith in Jesus Christ enlighten us and direct us?

Jesus wants to be with his disciples always, he desires to take them with him. "You know the way to the place I am going." But the apostles tended to forget the way. In reply to Thomas' question "How can we know the way?" Jesus says: "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one can come to the Father except through me." The one mission of Jesus was to reveal the Father. He alone reveals the Father in the 'way' he lives, in the 'truth' of his words and in the quality of new 'life' that he brings. Jesus reveals the Father in the 'ordinary routine' events of life. Jesus wants to renew our deep faith in Him. He also promises that those who believe in him will do the same works that he has done and even more. We know the works of God are to give life and to restore meaning in life. *This is our challenge today*, to engage in life-giving works and deeds. *Thomas A* Kempis wrote; "Without the Way, there is no going. Without the Truth, there is no knowing. Without the Life, there is no living." Jesus did not say, "I am a Way, a form of Truth, and a way of Life." He would not support the picking and choosing of his disciples as to who would be the best Apostle or popular among them. "I'll take the Beatitudes but not the Eucharist." The true is, it is of infinite importance. We need to put our faith and trust in Jesus. St. Peter says it well, "The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; This is because we all are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. We need to accept that light to gets the fruits and be blessed by God if only we believe.
