**Trinity Sunday:** The St Augustine of Hippo, a great philosopher and theologian, was thinking about the doctrine of the Blessed Trinity. He wanted so much to understand the doctrine of one God in three persons and to be able to explain it logically. One day he was walking along the sea shore and reflecting on this matter. He was given the answer by a little child trying to empty the sea into a hole in the sand with a shell in her hand." "How do you think," Augustine asked her, "that you can empty this immense sea into

this tiny hole and with this tiny cup?" She answered back, "And you, how do you suppose that with your small head you can comprehend the immensity of God?" When making the sign of the Cross we call on, "The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit" asking them to bless us on all that we are to undertake or accomplish. We begin and end our prayer invoking them. We see the unity of purpose among the three persons of the Trinity. When we think about this great feast-day and we recall, that the doctrine of the Three-in-Oneness of our God is one of the two most important truths of our Faith which we profess in the, "I believe".
