This celebration is presided by Bishop Richard Grecco and concelebrated with most priests of our diocese. At this ceremony, representatives of each parish receive, from our Bishop, the Holy Oils used throughout the year for the celebration of Baptism, Confirmation and the Sacrament of the Sick.
