From the Pastor's Desk



Palmer Road, P.E.I. November 16, 2015

Dear Bishop Grecco,

In the 80's I made the decision that I would never ask for a sabbatical of a few months or a whole year. The main reason is that I would feel guilty. As a member of the French Acadian clergy, I belong to a minority group. Rather, I chose to invest in a library; I continually read books all related to parish ministry.

On the occasion of my 25th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood, in 2006, Bishop Vernon Fougère granted me permission to be on retreat at the Abbey of the Genesee in Pifford, New York (December 10-22) and at the Bethlehem Hermitage, Chester, New Jersey (evening of December 22- 26). The Diocese covered all expenses. I resumed my parish duties on January 6, 2007 in St. John the Baptist Parish of Miscouche.

To mark my 35th anniversary, I would appreciate being a resident of the Abbaye Norte-Dame du Calvaire of Rogersville, New Brunswick for a month (March 28-April 25, 2016). I received permission from Dom Bede. My mandate, my goal to reach is to write my script for a book on spirituality, including as background an autobiography. Last December 12th, I was the guest speaker for our Diocesan Lay-Associate Program. Interestingly, I received very positive feedback on my passion for writing a daily spiritual journal entitled: "Cleopas" who is one of the disciples on the road to Emmaus.

I deliberately chose the Easter Season to be in this monastery because I truly believe that the risen Christ will inspire me and "my heart will be burning" as I wish and hope to accomplish my dream.

Fr Art Pendergast kindly accepted to be the presider of weekend and funeral liturgies during my absence if I receive your blessing.

As I make every effort to stay healthy, to live a well-balanced life and to daily experience "the Joy of the Gospel", I am expecting to remain very active during my senior years. There is longevity in my family: My maternal grandfather's first cousin died at the age of 114 and a number of my relatives lived to a ripe old age (their early 100's and late 90's). Being

able to experience "a special retreat" every 10 years will energize me physically, mentally and spiritually.
