Feast Day of St. Anne and St. Joachim Pilgrimage: Friday, July 29, St. Anne's Parish, Hope River, will celebrate the Feast Day of our Blessed Virgin Mary's parents and invites all pilgrims to celebrate Holy Mass at 10:30 am following a pilgrimage walk to the church.
