Triduum of Prayer for Peace in the Philippines

March 17-19: Due to continuing hostilities in Southern Philippines and the January 27th bombing during Sunday Mass at the Cathedral of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Jolo, Mindanao; the Knights of Columbus calls all members to stand in solidarity with their Filipino brothers and their families. Two Knights were among the more than 20 killed and four were among the 80 injured in the cathedral's bombing which the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines condemned as an 'act of terrorism". Knights throughout the Order are asked to join in three days of prayer, invoking the intercession of St Joseph as guardian and protector, beginning Sunday, March 17 and concluding Tuesday, March 19, the Solemnity of St Joseph. Sessions will be held at 3 p.m. each day at Immaculate Church, Palmer Road.
