Baptism of the Lord

The baptism of Jesus is another manifestation of Christ, another epiphany. Christ's baptism inaugurates his mission. In an analogous way, our Baptism inaugurates our mission as Christians.

This Sunday marks a transition from the Christmas season to Ordinary Time. In a way, today's feast is the high point of the Christmas season. Before Jesus' birth, angels announced to Mary and to Joseph who Jesus would be. At his birth, the shepherds and the Magi recognize Jesus as the Messiah. At his baptism, Jesus accepts that he is God's son and inaugurates that mission.

End of Rosary before 11 a.m. Mass

- (1) At the beginning of this New Year, the decision was made: No more recitation of the Rosary before Mass. The 15 minutes of silence before the Sunday Liturgy has not always been respected.
- (2) Sunday is the Lord's Day, the celebration of the Lord's sacred and memorial meal. It is Jesus gathering people together on Sunday, not the Blessed Mother. Poor timing is the issue!
- (3) Any group of people who want to gather for the recitation of the Rosary can share their devotion to Mary immediately after the Sunday Mass or at any time in the afternoon or in the evening. If there is a celebration of Baptism, those attending for the Rosary can meet in the chapel.
